INTRODUCTION:

If you are in Evesham or the surrounding area and you are homeless, face the risk of being homeless or are worried about being made homeless, then you may find this information handbook useful.

This guide provides an overview of the range of potential provision available in and around Evesham to meet the accommodation or other support needs of those who are homeless, struggling financially or who are likely to become homeless.

You will find information on who to talk to about trying to find accommodation, health issues involved with homelessness and other more general support available.
